

Women Jockey's in the Kentucky Derby

Although women have been training, breeding and owning Derby winners for decades, the first female jockey did not ride in the Kentucky Derby until 1970. In 1968, Kathy Kusner sued the Maryland Racing Commission for denying her a racing license. She won the battle, and this opened the door for women jockeys being able to obtain a racing license. The following are the 6 women who have competed in the Kentucky Derby.
